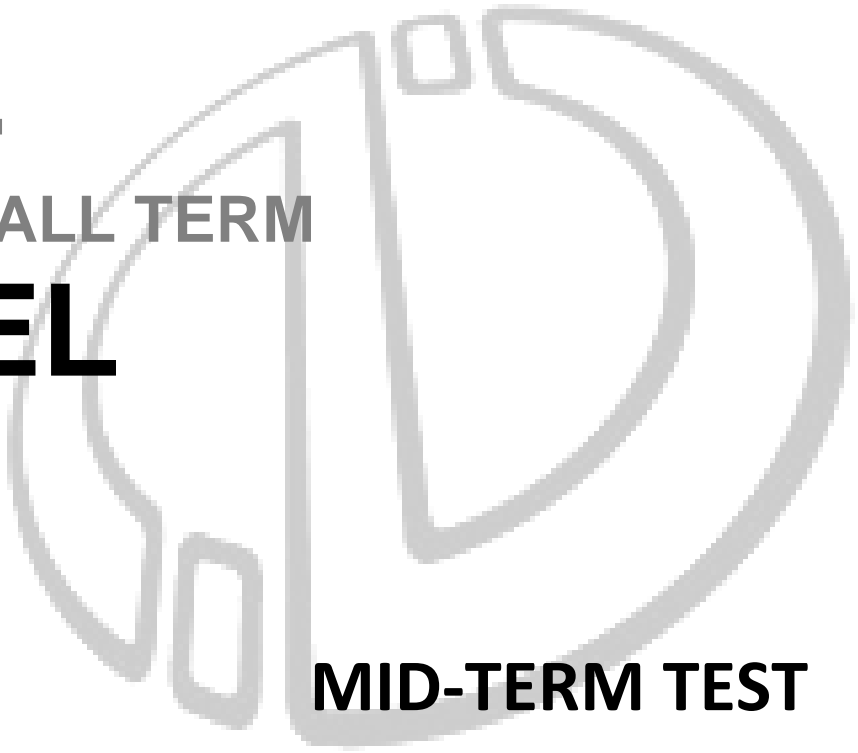

**A: The Japanese Diet**

People in Japan are generally very healthy and one of the main reasons is fish. The Japanese diet includes a lot of fish, which contains healthy oil. Another reason is that they also eat a lot of fruit and vegetables, for any meal, including breakfast. This is because: firstly, people eat small portions on separate plates, not one big plate.

**B: The Mediterranean Diet**

Health experts know that a lot of oil in your diet is unhealthy. The Mediterranean diet (for example, in Greece, Italy and Spain) contains a lot of oil, but it is a very healthy diet. This is because they use olive oil, which is good for your heart. Another important factor is that they eat a lot of fruit and vegetables. Vegetables in these countries are often main dishes.

**C: The South Indian Diet**

The South Indian diet is especially healthy as it contains a lot of fruit and vegetables. There is a long tradition of vegetarian food in this area. They eat meat, but not much. In South India, they add a lot of herbs and spices, like cinnamon, and turmeric, to their cooking.
